<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	Information within the SMR file references the 1964 Survey of Megalithic Tombs in County Mayo, which was carried out before peat extraction within the bog. In 1964 the tomb was recorded as follows: 'The tomb is poorly preserved. A row of four orthostats evidently represent the more northern side of a gallery aligned roughly WSW-ENE. These four are the only orthostats certainly in-situ. Two other firmly embedded stones are situated 2, to 2.5m north of the row. The remaining five large blocks are prostrate.'

<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	Located on a dip or small terrace on the NE slope of a heather and blanket bog covered hill, which rises prominently from a broad flat expanse of blanket bog. The cluster of large stones that comprise the tomb is partly concealed by blanket bog. Visible and relatively free of peat cover, is a NE-SW row of four large upright stones with a cluster of four smaller prostrate stones at its SW end. A large rounded boulder is located 2m to the NW of the SW end of the row, with two low stones barely visible in heather and peat, 0.8m to the NE and a large prostrate stone c. 90m to the NW.
